WHERE TO PARK With our downtown location, parking is sometimes perceived to be a challenge. However, ample parking is available to us, especially for those who are willing to do some walking. Here are some options for parking when you are attending events at Martin Luther Chapel:

- 6 parking spaces are located on the east side of the building, off of Park Lane. On Sundays and for other events, these are generally reserved for those with special needs.
- The City Hall parking lot, directly adjacent to our building, has space for 47 cars and is available for parking at no cost on Sunday, on Mondays thru Thursdays after 6:00 PM, and for special scheduled events during the week (check with the church office about parking for special events).
- The lot across Abbot, next to the AT&T building, is also available for use on Sunday at no cost, with space for 29 cars.
- Street parking is also available, on Sunday, with no need for a permit, on Elizabeth Street, Park Lane, and Grove Street. There is space for approximately 38 cars on these streets.
- The Grove Street Parking ramp is available, at no charge, every Sunday.
- The parking lot next to Dublin Square is available, at no charge, every Sunday, with space for 55 cars.
