International Ministry Teaching Opportunity

The Friendship House at Michigan State University is seeking volunteers to teach our international students, beginning early September. The teaching positions provide amazing opportunities to minister to people from around the globe, whether they are here in East Lansing or attending from somewhere else in the world.

We are seeking teaching volunteers who are either experienced teachers, or those with a strong desire to positively impact the lives of others. We at the Friendship House are willing to assist you, if necessary, in developing a curriculum or with anything else you may need. We greatly appreciate all of those who graciously volunteer their time and effort to teach those who come to the Friendship House seeking our assistance.

What you need to know:

- Our core curriculum is English as a Second Language (ESL), which can be taught in many forms, including Bible studies and others (for example, we've had a request for a course on the rules of American football).
- Our volunteers teach one class per week up to an hour and a half per class within the window of the semester timeframe (the number of weeks is determined by the curriculum and your availability).
- All classes are presented in a hybrid (in-person and virtual via Zoom) format, which allows both teachers and students to attend either in-person or from a remote location.
