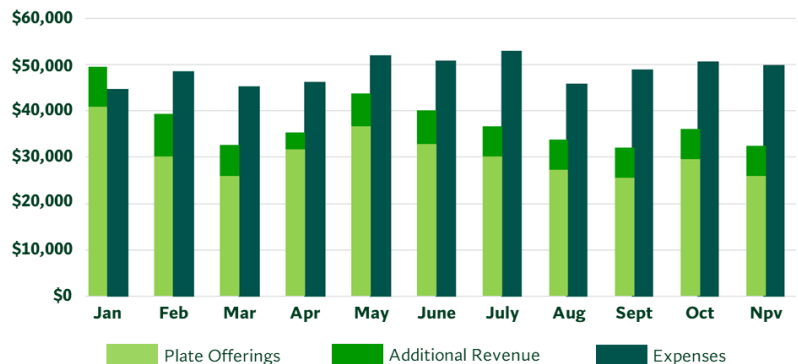
Spring Break Servant Event Trip Feb. 25-Mar 2
