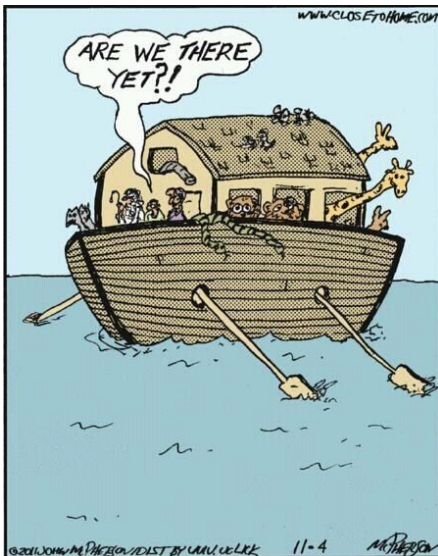

We are in desperate need of volunteers to teach our international students at the Friendship House beginning in January. The semester is Jan. 12 through Apr. 24.



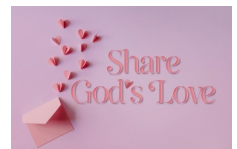
Friendship House
