## Adam Nevells Golf Outing

Following Adam's passing, in September 2009, Elaine, Matthew & Mike Nevells established the Adam Memorial Fund to honor his life and legacy. The Fund was created to give back to youth and the community Adam loved and that meant so much to him. Each year the Fund provides scholarships and grants to music, athletics, scouting, and Martin Luther Chapel. These gifts are funded through the interest earned, which allows Adam's Fund to continue giving back to the community for generations to come. As the Fund has grown, so have the annual gifts. Today, Adam's Fund balance is over \$175,000 and in the past 17 years has awarded over \$68,000, including more than \$26,000 to Martin Luther Chapel.
